Axel Schoenert architectes were commissioned by [Paris Inn Group](#) to refurbish the Paris-Gare de l'Est four-star hotel. Axel Schoenert founded the Franco-German agency Axel Schoenert architectes with the support of his wife Zsafia Varnagy, in 1999 in Paris, and developed its activities in architecture, interior and furniture design.

In Paris' 10th arrondissement, opposite the Gare de l'Est and close to the Gare du Nord, the hotel is enviably situated in this fast up-and-coming neighbourhood. Zsafia Varnagy & Axel Schoenert have redesigned the entire hotel, from the architectural reconfiguration of the spaces to the interior design, putting their mark on even the smallest details.

The hotel's 200 bedrooms has been increased to 206 following their development. The rooms are decorated in four different tones (turquoise, yellow, blue and violet), inspired by the colours and freshness of spring. The new lobby design focuses on optimising spaces in order to create an open and welcoming environment.

The hotel bar, which is open to the public, is furnished with a collection of furniture designed especially by Zsafia Varnagy. Five conference rooms, with windows to the outside, boast all the latest technology to ensure agreeable workspaces to meet every need. The overall interior design of the hotel encapsulates all the energy and vigour of spring, offering a luxurious setting for an enjoyable experience in the heart of Paris.
